- a) They are at least 21 years of age,
- b) They are a registered Scouter, eligible to serve as a Scoutmaster,
- c) They are active in Scouting work,
- d) They have demonstrated interest in the outdoor program of Scouting,
- e) They exhibit a sincere interest in Firecrafter,
- f) They meet one of the following additional qualifications:
 - 1) They are a professional Scouter or a member of the Council Executive Board and shall have been a registered Scouter for at least two years by the time of their nomination.
 - or 2) They are a key staff member at a Crossroads of America Council summer camp and shall have been registered with the Boy Scouts of America for at least two years by the time of their nomination and shall occupy a position of Camp Director, Program Director, Chaplain, Ranger, or department head in a major area of the camp.
 - or 3) They are a Scouter who resides outside the Crossroads of America Council and shall have been a registered Boy Scout leader for at least one year, and completed training anytime within that period for the position that they currently hold, or three years, if untrained for the position that they currently hold, by the time of their nomination, and shall have attended at least one long-term camping period in a Crossroads of America Council Boy Scout summer camp during the 24 months preceding their nomination, or with a special exemption of the Council Committee.
 - or 4) They are a Scouter who resides within the Crossroads of America Council and has been a registered Boy Scout leader for at least one year, and completed training anytime within that period for the position for that they currently hold, or three years, if untrained for the position that they currently hold, by the time of their nomination.
