What to Bring?

Tarp, rope for shelter, birds nest, knife, sleeping bag, sleeping pad, eating and cooking utensils, breakfast (1 or 2 eggs, a meat, bread, and a hot drink, bring in cooler, must pack out, be prepared to cook over an open fire), full class A uniform, work gloves, work clothes, Official BSA health form, hat, scout handbook, Backpack to carry belongings, Fire by friction set, shower materials, flashlight, batteries, water bottle, personal first aid kit, medication if needed, poncho, insect repellent

What not to bring?

Watch, mp3 player/iPod, tent, tent poles, tent stakes, lighter, matches, radio, chairs

Type of Health form?

Official BSA Health Form

What do I wear when I show up?

Work clothes, NOT CLASS A

What if these dates do not work for me?

If you went through the candidacy before mid summer, you need to talk to the chief to see if you can make next year's rituals. If you go through after mid summer, you may attend next years mid summer ritual. Basically you have one year to go through ritual after you complete your candidacy at summer camp.

Can my parents stay the weekend?

Not if they are not Firecrafters.

What if I am stuck in traffic?

What if I have other commitments and I need to come late?

You must be in camp by 7:00pm Friday night unless you have arrangements with the chief.

What is full Class A?

Class A shirt, Scout shorts, Scout belt, Scout socks, Pen

You are not allowed to attend ritual.
